



## PROJECT MANAGEMENT CASE STUDY

Over the period of 3 years a SSSI contracted a Project Manager and Deputy Project Manager a major international oil company operating in Sumatra, Indonesia. These expatriates were contracted to manage and develop the manned guarding, investigation and emergency reaction teams provided by a local Indonesian manned guarding company.

During the contract period the two managers oversaw the recruitment and training a 1000 man guard force to secure the oil company's vast sites which included expatriate compounds; management offices; workshops; oil fields and pumping stations.

Policies, procedures, standard operating procedures, emergency evacuation; contingency plans and training manuals were developed and implemented. A state of the art Central Control Room facility was also established – the systematic approach adopted by this management team ensured there were few disruptions to the client's day to day activities in this generally socially volatile part of the country.

On the eventual completion of the SSSI involvement in the project, the responsibility for managing this large and complex project was able to be handed over to a well trained team of local national management staff and supervisors.
